But though her voice is a little lower and little tougher, its power is undiminished. **ELIZABETH COOK**, who opens, was spit out of Warner Brothers' Nashville division after one album, 2002's *Hey Y'all*. **RUSSIAN** Brute force is how this local trio kicks it. Their music is pure, pummeling midwestern noise, terse and heavy and sure to warm the heart of anyone who can fondly recall the first time she heard Hammerhead or reminisce about a Cows show that changed her life. Pete Wagner's thick, swampy bass lines gouge a deep trench for the sinewy hooks of guitarist and front man Dave Arter, and Lauren Fitzpatrick pounds out her tom-heavy backbeat patterns like she's trying to drive her drums through the floor. The band keeps chord changes to a minimum, instead filling space with arcs of feedback and mammoth rumbles of distortion; Arter's monotone yawlping likewise ranges all the way from street-fight angry to drill-sergeant angry. For their entire four-year career Russian have been content to play a couple times a month in town, or maybe tour for a long weekend around the midwest in a supporting slot-they've released nothing and have no plans to do so, and in a day and age when a young band might line up a publicist and a booking agent two months after its first rehearsal, they don't even have a MySpace page. Sadly this is their last gig-Wagner and Fitzpatrick are moving to rural North Carolina at the end of the month, along with some of their friends in Milemarker (who won't be breaking up). 

## JIM BAKER | STEVE HUNT | BRIAN SANDSTROM | MARS WILLIAMS QUARTET

It was a big year for keyboardist Jim Baker-he not only released his first solo album, More Questions Than Answers (Delmark), but also convened this quartet, one of the most exciting working jazz bands in town. Every Tuesday since May the group—or a subset of its members—has played a couple sets of unfettered improvisation featuring woolly blowouts, atonal electronic soundscapes, rhapsodic ballads, and more. Baker's confederates-reedist Mars Williams, bassist-guitarist Brian Sandstrom, and drummer Steve Hunt-were all members of Hal Russell's NRG Ensemble, which held the free-jazz flame aloft during the music's decadelong winter in the 80s, and though the quartet doesn't sound like NRG, it channels that anarchic spirit.
